

    there for any reasonable time for the purpose of laying,
    inspecting, cleansing, repairing, maintaining, and renewing the pipe line or any part thereof and of opening up the
    soil of that land to such extent as may be necessary and
    reasonable in that regard, subject to the condition that
    as little disturbance as possible is caused to the surface of
    the land of the grantor and that the surface is restored
    as nearly as possible to its original condition and any other
    damage done by reason of the aforeasaid operations is
    repaired."

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
