

Shareholder Information Form

Introduction

This form must be completed in respect of any transfer of Water Shares in Waimea Irrigators Limited (**WIL**). Any transfer must be approved by WIL and then registered in WIL's share register in order for the transfer to be effective.

In order to facilitate this process, WIL requires the information set out below. Until WIL receives this information, it will not approve the transfer of the Water Shares and will not register the transfer in its share register. This means that the transferee will not have legal title to the Water Shares and the transferor will continue to own these shares and responsible for all obligations associated with them.

By acquiring Water Shares, the transferee will assume all of the obligations associated with those Water Shares, including responsibility for payment of all amounts that have not yet been paid to WIL in respect of those Water Shares, such as the outstanding purchase price for the shares, the construction operating charge, and all other Water Charges payable to WIL from time to time in accordance with its Constitution and its Shareholder Water Augmentation Agreement (**SWAA**).

WIL will incur costs as part of any transfer of Water Shares. The transferee will be responsible for meeting WIL's reasonable costs associated with the transfer (including legal costs).

WIL will prepare and provide the transferee with a SWAA for execution. The SWAA will need to be signed and returned to WIL on or before the transfer date, together with a validly executed Share Transfer Form, to enable WIL to approve and register the transfer.

Acknowledgement and Acceptance

By acquiring the Water Shares, the transferee:

- agrees to meet WIL's reasonable costs associated with the transfer of the Water Shares (including legal costs);
- agrees to pay all amounts that have not yet been paid to WIL in respect of those Water Shares;
- agrees to be bound by and to enter into the SWAA;

- acknowledges that the SWAA imposes a permanent obligation to pay Water Charges to WIL;
- acknowledges that Water Charges will be payable by direct debit to WIL and agrees to provide WIL with a direct debit authority in respect of Water Charges (including the Construction Operating Charge) upon request by WIL; and
- acknowledges that WIL may from time to time, amend the terms of the SWAA in accordance with the SWAA, and that the transferee will be bound by any such amendment on receiving written notice of the change.
